Each January the newly elected officers begin their new tasks contributing their time and effort towards improving our organization. The foundation for our Guild are its committees which provide the necessary services required to keep things running, dispensing helpful information to the members and plan for the future of the Guild. This work is accomplished by a small number of individuals. We encourage each member to get involved. Help carry the load by becoming an active committee member.

The following list of committees perform essential support for the Guild. Feel free to contact the chairman of the following committees and express your interest in serving.

- 1) **Library**
This committee maintains the Guild's library of books, videos and dvd's. Members may check these out at the monthly regular business meeting for a \$1.00 fee.
- 2) **Newsletter**
the editor produces our monthly newsletter' "Offcuts" which provides minutes of the previous month's business meeting, informational woodworking articles, and other relevant Guild information.
- 3) **Programs**
Woodworking programs are presented at each monthly business meeting. Scheduling speakers is the responsibility of the Vice President. Any assistance in facilitating these programs as well as suggestion in finding knowledgeable prospective speakers would be most welcome.
- 4) **Board Meeting**
This committee, chaired by the President, handles the general Guild administration, providing new ideas, projects, and improvements. It coordinates regular Guild functions such as the annual picnic and Holiday party. All members are welcome to attend
- 5) **Resources**
This committee provides woodworking information such as good sources, economical purchases and availability of tools, materials and supplies to our membership. Donated supplies required for guild projects are often obtained by this committee.
- 6) **Toy**
The Toy Committee is responsible for the production of various children's toys that are donated to underprivileged children through the Christmas Toy Shop of St. Petersburg and other charitable organizations. This is done by our organization as community service.
- 7) **Membership**
This committee maintains the membership roster for the guild, which is printed in the newsletter annually. A copy of the roster is provided to the newsletter editor prior to each "Offcuts" publication.
- 8) **Hospitality**
This committee greets visitors at each of our regular meetings. They field any questions about our organization. Each visitor is given a copy of our by-laws and a membership application and encouraged to join.
